Humanity in Art Award Milan 2018

In memory of Piero Amos Nannini

Art can be a way to investigate the meaning of humanity as a basic value essential for solidarity between living beings.

Società Umanitaria and the Association and Movement of Thought Arte da mangiare mangiare Arte, MAF – Museo Acqua Franca launch the first edition of the "Humanity in Art" Award Milan 2018, aiming at the promotion of Art as an expressive mean.

The Association has been active in the Artistic and Cultural panorama for 23 years with different projects and formats on the issues of healthy nutrition and environmental protection and has founded the first museum inside a wastewater treatment plant - MAF, Museo Acqua Franca.

The jury has selected more than 50 Italian and International artists whose works will be hosted in the historical spaces of the Società Umanitaria. Among the participating countries: Chile, Finland, France, Greece, Iran, Italy, Luxembourg, Portugal and Uruguay.

The Association intends to pay tribute to the figure of its past President Piero Amos Nannini and at the same time to join the historical mission of the Società Umanitaria in promoting culture and art.

The many initiatives organized in its headquarters facilities and in those of its decentralized offices - such as the Royal Villa of Monza, home to the University of Arts decorations of Monza, later ISIA - have allowed Umanitaria to reach a solid reputation also at international level: on one hand with its schools of arts and crafts, where the students could follow the lessons of Alessandro Mazzucotelli, Eugenio Quadri, Guido Marussig, Marino Marini, Alfredo Ravasco and many others, on the other hand with art exhibitions such as the Exhibition of Free Art in 1911, where also Boccioni and Carrà exhibited, and the Biennal of Monza, later transformed into the Triennale of Milan.

The Humanity in Art Award 2018 is divided into 5 sections: Painting and Drawing, Digital Graphic Arts, Sculpture and Installation, Photography and Performance.

During the Vernissage, the 10 winner artists will be announced, choosen for their relevance to the theme and originality in
